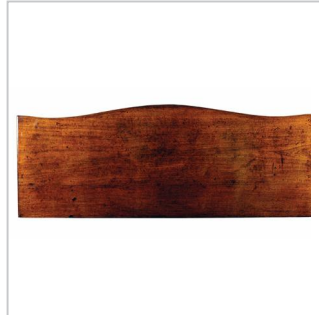


SHERATON PERIOD MAHOGANY SERPENTINE SERVING TABLE - REF 2055
