

A PAIR OF REGENCY POLLARD OAK AND KINGWOOD BANDED CARD TABLES - REF 2110



A fine pair of Regency burr pollard oak card tables. The top of rectangular shape with rounded front corners, strung with partridge wood and cross-banded in kingwood. The top swivels and opens to reveal a baize lined playing surface, with compartments beneath.

The frieze with a central rectangular panel, front corner panels and a rear panel to the back of each side of the frieze, all cross-banded in partridge wood and a further partridge wood cross banding runs around the lower circumference .

The tables have a tapering square section central column, with a pinched lower half and gadrooned ankle on a scalloped platform base. They are supported by curved tapering legs with applied ebony paterae to the knee and terminating in cast scrolling flower capped castors

A fine pair of particularly good colour and patina throughout.
