

### GEORGE I WALNUT & GILTWOOD PIER MIRROR - REF 2305

A fine quality early George I walnut and parcel-gilt pier mirror. The crest of scrolling shaped form, with giltwood edge, with a central circular recessed carved shell crest.

Below, the shaped rectangular divided bevel plate engraved with a crown, star and plant motif to the upper plate, with a stepped and shaped surround, with giltwood inside and outside edge.

A superb mirror, retaining excellent original colour and patina throughout.
