A fine and important George III Hepplewhite period carved mahogany and marquetry serpentine concertina action card table. The mahogany serpentine top with front re-entrant corners, fluted frieze edge, a central marquetry circular patera, unusual husk marquetry corners and cross-banded in satinwood. The top opens to reveal a green baize lined playing surface and is supported by a concertina action. The frieze in flame mahogany with carved central detailing and carved fluted lower edge. The table is supported on fine cabriole legs with leaf carved hips and toes with carved detailing throughout. A delightful, superb quality piece illustrated in the Moss Harris Centenary book.
