

## GEORGE II CARVED MAHOGANY SIDE TABLE IN THE MANNER OF THOMAS CHIPPENDALE - REF 2353



An important, excellently proportioned George II carved mahogany side table, in the manner of Thomas Chippendale, retaining excellent original colour and patina. The top constructed of well chosen figured veneers, on a solid mahogany base with banded figured mahogany edge. Below the frieze with a crisply carved c-scroll leaf central crest, with intricate floral and c-scroll applied carvings emanating from the centre to all visible sides of the frieze. The legs of square chamfered section fluted and beaded to the front with intricately carved leaf c-scroll ears to the top, a beaded ankle and pad foot to the bottom.
