A fine pair of George III painted and carved giltwood armchairs possibly by Thomas Chippendale. The oval backs with moulded gilt edge surrounds, carved in relief with a floral crest and central leaf decoration. The out-swept moulded arms with padded rests and a moulded scrolled hand hold, curving down towards the seat with relief carved floral decoration. The seat with serpentine front rail, inset with a central carved bow and emanating floral decoration. The chairs are supported by fluted swelling baluster legs to the front and out-swept legs to the rear.

*These chairs are near identical to others which are known to have been made by Chippendale, the quality of construction and detailing is evident throughout.*
